

Electronic uDNAR on EMIS

The uDNAR form can be uploaded as a word document in EMIS. It can still be completed by hand if preferred. The option of completing electronically and sharing via email in some cases might be helpful.

Please note that we are not permitted to change the form in any way and the following need to be noted:

- There is only need to print off page 2 onwards
- Triplicate copies are not required
- Only one hard copy is necessary and this should stay with the patient at all times
- Printing on lilac paper – WHITE paper is now permitted
- Not all areas of the form will self-populate and care must be taken to ensure that all areas are completed in full eg CPR is unlikely to be successful due to:
 - Ensure that the form has your name, GMC number and electronic signature
 - Ensure that you scroll down to the very end of the document and review all sections

Once you have completed the uDNAR a copy can be printed off on lilac paper and given to the patient/carer to keep with them at all times

Or

The completed uDNAR can be sent securely via nhs.net to the patient's address. This might be helpful for patients living in care homes where the care home staff can print off the completed form and place in the patient's notes.
